## PREFATORY NOTE.

---

IN the following pages we give a brief account of the Suspension of the City of Glasgow Bank, and a complete list of persons holding Stock on the 17th day of July 1878, and of persons who have held Stock therein at any time during the year immediately preceding that date, showing their names and addresses, and an account of the Stock so held, and the amount of the first Call due thereon. In reference to the entries to which an asterisk (\*) has been appended, we have explained in a Note that these give account of holdings which, having been transferred within twelve months, still involve liability on the part of the former holders, under the conditions specified in the 28th section of the Act of Parliament, as indicated below:—

“(1.) No past member shall be liable to contribute to the assets of the Company if he has ceased to be a member for a period of one year or upwards prior to the commencement of the winding-up.

“(2.) No past member shall be liable to contribute in respect of any debt or liability of the Company contracted after the time at which he ceased to be a member.

“(3.) No past member shall be liable to contribute to the assets of the Company unless it appears to the Court that the existing members are unable to satisfy the contributions required to be made by them in pursuance of the Act.”

If the present Shareholders, therefore, are unable to meet the liabilities of the Bank, past members can be called upon to make good the debts, so far as contracted prior to the date at which they ceased to be members, if that date be at a period less than one year from the time the Liquidation begins.

We also give a list of Shareholders who have purchased Stock since the 17th of July to the 1st of October, and a complete list of Trustees on Estates holding Stock.

## THE CITY OF GLASGOW BANK.

### INTRODUCTORY.

THIS great social and commercial disaster—the result of utterly reckless and dishonest speculation on the part of the Glasgow Board of Directors—was made public late in the evening of the 1st of October, by the resolution of the Directors to close their doors on the following morning. When the announcement appeared in the newspapers of Wednesday, October 2, the public was completely taken by surprise; and some days elapsed before it could be realised what a crushing blow had fallen on the unfortunate Shareholders, and on the credit of the country.

Our purpose here is simply to chronicle, for future reference, the principal facts connected with the collapse of the Bank—an event which will long be remembered by thousands in Scotland as the saddest and darkest in their history, inasmuch as it carried ruin and desolation into happy homes in almost every town and village in the country, making bankrupts of hitherto prosperous merchants, sweeping away the provision laid up against adversity and declining strength, and depriving hundreds of widows and children of the barest necessities of life.

### FORMATION OF THE BANK.

The City of Glasgow Bank was established in 1839. Having its head office in Virginia Street, Glasgow, it carried on no fewer than 133 branches, including four in the Isle of Man (the Bank of Mona), one of which was recently the scene of a remarkable robbery. The partnership numbered 1249; and the paid-up capital amounted to £1,000,000 sterling. With an authorised circulation of £72,921, it showed an average circulation for the four weeks ending 31st August last of £596,689, the average amount of coin held during the same period being certified as £576,302.

### STOPPAGE AND RESUSCITATION IN 1857.

In November 1857, the Bank, succumbing to the heavy run occasioned by the failure of the Western, was obliged to suspend payment; but after the panic had died down, it was enabled to resume business. The assets were then stated at £5,107,000, the liabilities at £4,445,060, to which fell to be added £15,640 of profits, making in all £667,533. There was a deficiency in the capital account to the extent of £77,000; but the money necessary to warrant a fresh start was readily forthcoming.

### LAST DIVIDEND AND BALANCE-SHEET.

The Bank has since gone on with results which, up to the stoppage, had maintained its Stock at the high figure of £240 per £100 share; and so recently as July last, when a dividend of 12 per cent. was declared, the Directors submitted the following statement of the Bank's position:—

## THE COLLAPSE.

The newspapers of 2d October contained the following official announcement:—

THE DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF GLASGOW  
BANK having intimated their resolution NOT TO OPEN THEIR DOORS for BUSINESS TO-MORROW, and to CEASE the ISSUE of NOTES, the UNDERSIGNED BANKS HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that, with a view to lessen the inconvenience of the stoppage to the public, they will receive, in the ordinary course of business, the notes of the said Bank now in circulation.

(Here follow the names of the ten Banks.)

1ST OCTOBER 1878.

As a last resource, the Directors applied for assistance to the other banking companies; but the latter having obtained a report from Mr Auldjo Jamieson, C.A., to the effect that an examination of the books showed a worse state of affairs than had been represented, the request was refused. Learning on Tuesday evening that no assistance could be accorded them, the City Directors forthwith resolved to close their doors. The policy adopted by the Scotch bankers as a body of cashing the notes had the effect of keeping down any tendency to panic. Neither in Edinburgh, Glasgow, nor London, was there the least appearance of a run upon the other Banks.

## COMMITTEE OF INVESTIGATION.

Messrs Anderson and M'Grigor, Glasgow, were appointed by the Directors to investigate the affairs of the Bank, with the view of submitting a report to the Shareholders. At a meeting of the Directors, on Saturday, 5th October, these gentlemen reported, that although they had as yet been able only in the most cursory manner to examine into the condition of the Bank, they were satisfied that it was impossible for it to continue its business, and that it would be advisable to wind up its affairs. They therefore recommended that, in the interest of the Shareholders, no time should be lost in having it put in liquidation; and that, with this view, the Shareholders should be called together under the provisions of the Companies Acts. It was accordingly resolved to call an extraordinary general meeting of Shareholders for the 22d October, to resolve as to whether the Bank should be wound up, and if so resolved, to appoint Liquidators.

## OFFICIAL REPORT OF INVESTIGATORS.

The text of the Official Report of the Committee of Investigation was published in full in the newspapers of Saturday, 9th October, and its startling disclosures intensified the prevailing gloom. No one expected that the deficiency would be so great, or the maladministration of the Directors so flagrant. Briefly stated, the Report showed the deficiency to be no less than £5,190,983, 11s. 3d., and when to this sum is added the capital of one million, the total loss amounts to £6,190,983, 11s. 3d.

The following balance-sheet, prepared by the Investigators as at 1st October, exhibits a curious contrast to that of the Directors published on the 3d July, printed on a preceding page:—

## ARREST OF MANAGER, SECRETARY, AND DIRECTORS.

The Report of the Investigation Committee had not been printed for many hours before, at the instance of the Lord Advocate and the Procurator-fiscal for Lanarkshire, a warrant was obtained for the apprehension of the Manager, Secretary, and Glasgow Board of Directors. The arrests were quietly made in Glasgow and Edinburgh on Saturday evening, October 19; and on Monday, the whole passed the bar of the Police Court, and were remitted to the Sheriff on a charge of fraud. Subsequently the prisoners were lodged in Duke Street prison. On the 29th, they were further charged with the theft of bills left for collection to a large amount (£20,000), and formally committed for trial. Subsequently, Mr John Stewart was released on a bail-bond for £15,000. After a full debate before the Court, bail was refused in the case of the other Directors and Officials.

## MEETING OF SHAREHOLDERS.

The meeting of Shareholders took place on 22d October, in the City Hall, Glasgow, when it was unanimously resolved to wind up the affairs of the Bank by voluntary liquidation. Subsequently, on appeal to the Court of Session by London creditors, the liquidation was ordered to proceed under the supervision of the Court. The liquidators are Messrs George A. Jamieson, C.A., Edinburgh; James Haldane, C.A., Edinburgh; William Anderson, C.A., Glasgow; John Cameron, Clydesdale Bank, Glasgow.—Messrs Davidson & Syme, W.S., 22 Castle Street, are the law agents.

## FIRST CALL OF £500 PER SHARE.

The Liquidators, on 25th October, resolved that the first call made on the Partners shall be £500 per £100 of Stock, to be paid in instalments of £250 on 23d December, and £250 on 24th February. The intelligence of the amount of call had a depressing effect on the Glasgow Stock Exchange. The following is the official intimation of the call:—

"At a meeting of the Liquidators held this day, it was resolved to make a call upon the Shareholders of £500 per £100 of Stock, payable in two equal instalments on 23d December and 24th February respectively. At a conference held with the Committee of Shareholders, the Liquidators intimated their anxious desire to give every assistance and facility to Shareholders who might find it difficult to realise their assets on the moment, except at serious loss."

The first call, were every one to pay, will realise £4,000,000; but it is estimated to produce not more than £2,500,000. On the other hand, it is feared that the ultimate liabilities, with interest and the expenses of litigation, will reach £7,000,000. The Caledonian Banking Company, in consequence of holding four Shares, was under the necessity of closing its doors (Dec. 5, 1878).

There has been a serious fall in the price of all Securities, particularly Bank Stock, since the failure, as will be seen from the latest quotations:—

The capitals of all the Scotch Banks now carrying on business amount to £9,000,000. The market value recently was £26,500,000. It is now estimated as worth only £20,000,000. The property belongs to more than 14,000 persons.

Trustees are personally liable as Shareholders for all Stock entered in the Register in their name. "The state of the law relating to trustees," says the *Economist*, "makes it gross imprudence for a man to be trustee of shares in any enterprise of unlimited liability."
