### THE

## CITY OF GLASGOW NATIVE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION.

### Founded June, 1844.

This venerable Association was founded in June, 1844, by James Lumsden, who was then the Lord Provost of the City, and has a record of benevolence to its credit over the long period of one hundred years. During that time it has distributed close on £115,000 to worthy citizens, their widows and families, who from reverses of fortune were in need of assistance.

The whole object of the Association is to give aid to such people and renew their courage to face life's difficulties and make them realise that friends exist to help them on their way.

### Membership.

The Association is open to all who are natives of Glasgow and those who have carried on business on their own account in the city or through long residence or commercial connections have been identified with the city. Their families are also eligible for membership. The only payment asked is a single payment of £5 5/-. There is no annual subscription.

Ladies who are natives of the City of Glasgow are eligible for membership, and the wives and daughters of Members are specially invited to join.

Through the hundred years of its existence the Capital Funds have steadily grown and now amount to £72,960 19s. 1d.

Last year the Society was in a position to distribute grants amounting to £2518, all of which was much needed and greatly appreciated.

### ARTICLES AND RULES

OF THE

## City of Glasgow Native Benevolent Association

(INSTITUTED IN 1844)

Ι.

The Association shall be called "THE CITY OF GLASGOW NATIVE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION," and this Name shall not be changed without the consent of four-fifths of the Members.

II.

The object of the Association is to raise a fund to be employed in affording assistance to the Members of the Association and Natives of the City of Glasgow, and the Widows and Families of the Members of the Association and of Natives of the City of Glasgow, who, from reverses of fortune, or otherwise, have been reduced to necessitous circumstances.

### III.

Any person shall be qualified to be elected as a Member of the Association who (a) is a native of the City of Glasgow; (b) has been identified by long residence or commercial connections with the interests and prosperity of the City or is otherwise prominently associated with the City; or (c) is the husband, wife or child of anyone qualified under (a) or (b) hereof.

### IV.

Every Member shall subcribe the sum of Five Guineas to the Funds of the Association.

V.

Donations, Legacies and Bequests are invited from those, either at home or abroad, who approve of the object for which the Association has been founded.

A meeting of the Association shall be held once every year during the month of October for the purpose of transacting the ordinary business of the Association.

#### VII

The direction and management of the whole affairs and business of the Association shall be vested in, and intrusted to, a President, three Vice-Presidents, twelve Extraordinary and sixteen Ordinary Directors, a Treasurer, and a Secretary who shall be chosen by open vote by a majority of the Members present at the Annual General Meeting. An interim Secretary or Treasurer may be appointed by a majority of the Ordinary Directors but such appointments shall not be valid beyond the date of the Annual General Meeting first occurring after the date of such interim appointments.

### VIII.

The President shall be elected for three years successively, but shall not be capable of re-election for one year after the expiry of the third year of office. The Vice-Presidents, Extraordinary and Ordinary Directors, and the Treasurer and the Secretary shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. The Ordinary Directors shall be capable of re-election, with the exception of the four whose names stand first on the list for the time, who shall retire from office for one year but may thereafter be re-elected.

The Ordinary Directors at their first meeting following the Annual General Meeting shall elect one of their number as Chairman, who for the time being shall have a casting as well as a deliberative vote.

### IX.

The President, or in his absence one of the Vice-Presidents, or in their absence the Chairman of Directors, shall be Preses at the Annual General Meeting of the Association and shall subscribe the Minutes thereof; and in all cases of equality of votes, the Preses for the time being shall have a casting as well as a deliberative vote.

#### X

The Extraordinary Directors shall only deal with the business of the Association on occasions when their assistance and advice may be required by six of the Ordinary Directors for the time being, and they shall then act and vote with all the powers competent to the Ordinary Directors.

### XI.

The Directors shall meet, as it shall be found necessary, on the business of the Association. The President, Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, and the Secretary shall be Directors ex officiis; six Directors shall constitute a quorum, and be sufficient for the despatch of business.

#### XII.

The Directors are empowered to determine the election of candidates for Membership, and to regulate both the investment and the distribution of the Funds of the Association, in terms of these Articles and Rules. It is an instruction to the Directors, that Members, and the Widows and Families of Members, are entitled to a preference in the distribution of the Funds. No person shall have any legal right to demand aid from the Association, and the granting, withholding or withdrawal of the same or increasing or reducing the amount thereof shall be entirely in the discretion of the Directors. The Association contemplates not such casual or trivial relief as is properly obtained from the funds destined by law for the support of the poor, but rather such more ample and efficient assistance as may tend to secure comparative ease to the parties on whom it is bestowed.

### XIII.

The Treasurer shall collect, receive, and discharge all Subscriptions, Donations, Legacies, Rents, Interest, Dividends, and other sums belonging and due to the Association; and shall pay all Accounts and Debts due by the Association, and all Pensions and Allowances granted by the Directors. He shall keep a regular account of his Receipts and Disbursements, and shall lodge in a Bank, to be named from time to time by the Directors, in name of the Association all funds which come into his hands, which lodgments, whether Deposit Receipt Account, Savings Account or Current Account, may be withdrawn either by endorsation or by cheques signed by any two of the Chairman of Directors, the Treasurer and the Secretary, for the time being. The Treasurer's Books and Accounts shall at all times be patent to the Directors, and at the last meeting of Directors preceding the Annual General Meeting the Treasurer shall exhibit, first, an Account of his Intromissions for the previous year, and second, a Report on the State of Affairs of the Association at the date of the Report, which Account shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Directors and submitted for adoption at the Annual General Meeting.

### XIV.

The Secretary shall have the custody of all the Secretarial Books, Pensions Register and Papers of the Association. He shall call all meetings of the Association and Directors, the former to be advertised in two Glasgow Newspapers and also by circular to all Members within a radius of twenty miles of Glasgow at least seven days before the day of Meeting. He shall attend all such Meetings, and write and engross the Minutes of the proceedings, and shall conduct the correspondence of the Association, and if he is a practising Solicitor, transact any legal business which may occur, and shall receive the usual remuneration for such professional services. The Treasurer and the Secretary shall be entitled to receive such remuneration for their services as may be agreed upon from time to time by the Directors.

### XV.

The Funds of the Association shall be invested in securities authorised for Trustees according to the law of Scotland. Such securities shall be taken in the names of the President, Treasurer, and the Secretary of the Association for the time being, and their successors in office, as Trustees for the Association, or in the name of the nominees of the Association's Bankers if more convenient, but in the latter event an acknowledgment shall be obtained by the Secretary from such Nominees or Bank that the latter hold the investments in question for behoof and to the order of the President, Treasurer and the Secretary of the Association for the time being. Notwithstanding the foregoing the Directors in their sole discretion, shall be entitled to accept non-statutory Trustee Investments and assets in satisfaction, or in satisfaction pro tanto of any Legacy or Bequest to the Association, and such investments and assets after acceptance shall be retained (without liability for so doing) or realized solely at the discretion of the Ordinary Directors.

#### XVI.

It shall at no time be in the power of the Directors to expend more than the annual income of the Funds of the Association, and of the additions which may be made to the Funds by Subscriptions, Donations, Legacies, or otherwise, unless in cases where the Donors or Testators may otherwise appoint. The Directors may also divide a further sum not exceeding one-half of entry monies received during the preceding year.

#### XVII.

A Special General Meeting of the Association may be called at any time on a requisition addressed to the Secretary, signed by six Directors or twelve Members.

### XVIII.

The Association shall be entitled to sue and defend, in all questions in which it may be interested, in the names of the President, Treasurer, and the Secretary for the time being.

### XIX.

The Members of the Association shall, at all times, have it in their power to alter and amend the foregoing Articles and Rules, and to make new and additional Articles and Rules, but that only at the Annual General Meeting, after three months' notice, of the alterations and amendments proposed but not unless such alterations and/or amendments are approved of by two-thirds of the Members present, or four-fifths of the Members in the case of the first Article.
