# The David Borland Golf Competition

## Introduction



David Borland  
Deacon Barbers  
1919

Before reading the minutes of the David Borland Golf Competition, it may be worth considering who David Borland was. David Borland was Collector of the Incorporation of Barbers in 1917 and became Deacon in 1919 prior to becoming Collector of the Trades House in 1921. David passed away at 7a.m. in his home at 11 Newlands Road, Glasgow leaving behind him his wife Jane Dobbie and five children: Winfred Dobbie Borland (Born 1905), Ian Howie Borland (Born 1907), Gladys Middleton Borland (Born 1909) and Cecil Ross Borland (Born 1913). David was the second youngest of the family being born in 1911.

The cause of David's death was a cerebral haemorrhage which he suffered from for 1½ days. David was listed as a Sugar Broker at the time of his death.

David's brother George Middleton Borland was made Deacon of the Incorporation of Bakers in 1920, the year after David stood down as Deacon and survived David by nine years when he passed away on 15 February 1930.

David's parents, John Borland who was a lace manufacturer, and Agnes Howie were deceased at the time of their son's death in 1921.

On passing away on the 9<sup>th</sup> October 1921, David's demise was shortly before the election of the Deacon Convener which took place on the 12<sup>th</sup> October 1921.

Deacon Convener Robert Davidson referred to the sudden death of David Borland in the following manner:

*"Minutes of the Trades House of Glasgow at and within the Trades Hall of Glasgow, the 12<sup>th</sup> Day of October, 1921.*

*Before proceeding to the business of the Meeting, the Convener referred feelingly to the recent death of Collector Borland. He said: -*

*A very sad event has taken place within, the last few days which has cast a gloom over our proceedings this morning. It cannot fail to be present in our minds in the ceremony of to-night, which everyone of us had hoped would be carried through as usual without any vestige of sorrow. But death has been busy with his sickle, and to our deep regret we have lost our esteemed Collector. Such a thing has happened, but rarely in our history and still more seldom than at a time so near our Annual Meeting.*

*Collector Borland was a native of Newmilns. He came to Glasgow in his early years, where he established, along with his brother, Deacon George Borland, what has since become the successful and well-known firm of Borlands Limited. Since then he has done much to encourage and foster the staple industry of his native town. A keen man of business, he was also a man of high character and of an extremely generous disposition. Strong affection for the town of his birth was exemplified in many kind actions for the good of the community. His benefaction to his Craft, the Barbers, in establishing and endowing a special charitable fund and his last token of regard for*

*the House itself, when he presented to it in trust a beautiful silver golf cup, were characteristic of the man.*

*Soon after he was elected to the Master Court in 1915, he set about instilling new life into his Craft. When he became Collector of the Barbers in 1917, he immediately interested his many friends in its work, introduced 167 new members and brought in £3,717 in entry money, a sum which has never been reached by any other Craft.*

*Although only two years in the House, and one year on the Platform, his methods of work were rapidly becoming noticeable and I bearing fruit. The loss has come upon us at a time when his fresh ideas would have been of much value to us all here.*

*As a husband and father those who knew him intimately speak of him with the highest praise. We all sincerely mourn for our Collector, but above all we condole with his bereaved widow and children, a young family left without the guidance of a devoted and loving father. Our best sympathies go out towards them all in the sudden and sad blow which has fallen upon them.*

*I move that we record in these words our great sorrow, and that the deep sympathy of the House be conveyed to Mrs. Borland and her family by forwarding to her an excerpt from the Minute of this Meeting."*

Unfortunately, the minutes of the Competition refer very seldom to David Borland.



**The David Borland Cup**

One must wonder why David Borland thought that there was a need for a second Golf Competition when one had been set up in 1905. The reason is quite simple, the 1905 competition was for members of the Master Courts and the Clerks of the Master Courts and was a two-ball handicap, foursome competition. The new competition was designed to attract all members from the Incorporations who played golf and would be four players or more with the best four scores going towards the competition, again handicaps were taken into consideration.

The wonderful cup, see left was presented by him a mere 16 days prior to his demise.

The Minutes of the Trades House of Glasgow for 23<sup>rd</sup> Day of September, 1921, gives a clear outline of the donation of the Cup and its purpose.

*"In the absence of the Collector, the Deacon-Convener accepted on behalf the House, as a gift from Collector Borland, the Silver Cup on the table. The purpose of the Cup is to encourage and maintain amongst the Guild Brethren of Craft Rank, an annual Golf Competition (as distinct from the annual competition for the Golf Trophy, which is open only to Members of the Master Courts).*

*The Deacon-Convener accepted the Cup as the actual property of the Trades House, and as a gift presented in the first place for a golf competition among the Guild Brethren of the Fourteen Incorporations. Should the occasion arise, the House would have power to adopt other measures from time to time as will put the Cup into competition for some other recreation.*

*The cordial thanks of the House was enthusiastically voted to the Collector for his generous gift.*

*The Meeting resolved that rules of the annual golf game of the Guild Brethren of Craft Rank be drawn up by the Committee and submitted to the House for approval.*

*Instructions were then given for the Cup to be insured against burglary and fire, wherever it may be in custody, within a radius of ten miles from the Cross of Glasgow."*

A Sub-Committee consisting of Messrs J A Dow, A L Holmes, James B Benzies and A Frood was appointed to make the draw and the final arrangements for the Competition.
