

CONSTITUTION.

1. The Club shall be called “THE GLASGOW ROYAL INFIRMARY CLUB.”

2. The following shall be eligible for membership, viz. :—

Past or present Resident Assistants ;

Past or present Superintendents ;

Past or present Members of the Medical and Surgical Staff. (All of the Glasgow Royal Infirmary.)

3. The object of the Club shall be to unite its Members in a close bond of fellowship, and to further this object a Dinner shall be held annually in Glasgow on the second Friday in March.

4. The management of the Club shall be entrusted to a Committee consisting of eight Members and two Joint Secretaries (one of whom shall also act as Treasurer). Two of the Members of Committee shall

be Resident Assistants, to be elected annually by the Residents. Two other Members of Committee shall retire annually, but shall be eligible for re-election. The Secretaries shall retire annually, but shall also be eligible for re-election. Three shall form a quorum of the Committee.


5. The Committee shall each year nominate a Chairman to preside at the Annual Dinner. The Chairman shall be *ex-officio* a Member of Committee.

6. The Life Subscription of the Club shall be 10/6. Resident Assistants, while holding office as such, may be admitted to the Dinner without becoming Members of the Club.

7. There shall be no Guests present at the Annual Dinner except those of the Club, and these shall be selected by the Committee.

8. The Secretaries shall keep a Minute of all Meetings of the Club, and the Statement of Accounts shall be entered in the Minutes of each Annual Meeting.


9. The Club shall not be dissolved without the written consent of two-thirds of the total membership.







PAST CHARMEN.

Notes on the Old G.R.I.

* * *

SINCE the year 1894 the Glasgow Royal Infirmary Residents have held an Annual Dinner to which past Residents and members of the present and past staff were invited.

At the Dinner held in 1906 it was considered advisable to have a more permanent Committee in charge of the Dinner arrangements. Drs. W. K. Hunter, Hugh MacLaren, John Patrick, Robert Ramsey, and Jas. Scott were elected ; the senior and another Resident of each term to be also members of Committee.

The Constitution of the Club was prepared by the Committee of the year 1907, and was passed at the next Annual Meeting.

The production of an accurate list of G.R.I. Residents has proved a work of extreme difficulty, if not an impossible task.

From 1795 till 1894 the names are given in the Annual Reports, except during the years 1840-1843. During those latter years no record was kept. A number of names are mentioned in the Secretaries' Minutes of Meetings of Managers, and a perusal of these long and carefully kept Minutes reveals the fact that in those days few meetings of Managers occurred without one or more of the Residents appearing before them to answer for various charges of misconduct.

The publication of the names of those thus distinguished seems hardly fair when their more peaceful brethren remain unknown ; and so we have left these years blank.

From 1867-94 we have a list kindly lent by the late Dr. Moses Thomas ; unfortunately the full christian names have not been given, and so it has often been very difficult to identify members. After 1894 the list has been taken from "the G.R.I. Residents' Book," started by Dr. Barr Stevens, who first made an effort to make out a list of G.R.I. Residents.

The list gives an interesting history of the growth of our old Infirmary, from the days when the Resident Staff consisted of a physician's clerk, a surgeon's clerk who also acted as apothecary, the matron and a porter, to the present time with its imposing army of officials.

Special rules were made for regulating the duties of the physicians' and the surgeons' clerks, the latter being enjoined to "have an assortment of bandages in readiness, particularly of those necessary in capital operations. . . . He is also to study neatness in dressing, instructing the dressers in this necessary art, and is to be careful that there be no waste of caddis, strap, or other material used by the dressers."

The apothecary was the custodian of the ward journals, received students' fees and the money paid by patients.

He was also in charge of the mortuary, and with the matron superintended the domestic economy of the house. It was their duty to see that the gates were locked every night at ten, after which hour the Mana-

gers "expect that no member of the family shall be absent from the house without leave."

Along with his more usual duties the porter had to "shave, administer injections, take charge of the baths prescribed, and in short, so far as he shall be able, do whatever may be reasonably required of him in connection with the business of the house, by the matron, apothecary or clerks."

The physicians were two in number and were chosen annually, one retiring from office each year.

The four surgeons were also chosen annually, two retiring each year, and were not eligible again for two years.

They attended daily at one o'clock. "No operation was to be performed unless determined on at a consultation regularly summoned."

The following notes on the foundation and growth of our old G.R.I. have been added in the hope that they may prove of interest, especially as in a short time few of the old landmarks will remain.

These notes are necessarily scrappy, as it has been considered better to keep them in chronological order.

They are taken from the old carefully recorded Minutes of Managers' Meetings and the old reports, and also from Dr. Moses Buchanan's History of the Glasgow Royal Infirmary of 1830. Material for a history of the growth of medicine and surgery is here in plenty, but it has been considered necessary to restrict the facts recorded mainly to those connected with the buildings and with the duties of the medical and surgical staff. Unfortunately the social aspect of the

G.R.I. history could not be well dealt with as our material does not deal with this aspect.

It is to be hoped, however, that some one will make good this defect before the traditions of the old G.R.I. have passed away.

On the 5th June, 1787, a meeting of those interested in the foundation of an Hospital in Glasgow was held.

Professor Jardine and Dr. Stevenson appear to have been the originators of the scheme. On the 24th of the same month a committee, chosen to collect subscriptions and search for a suitable site, reported that they had found a site, giving the following as their reasons for their choice:—“(1) The site of the (Archbishop’s) castle and yard contain near two Scotch acres, which is fully sufficient for the building of the Infirmary and other conveniences, and for a walk for the patients. (2) The situation is high and well aired, and cannot at any time be surrounded by buildings, and there is a great descent from it, by which perpetual cleanliness and dryness may be perfectly secured. (3) There is a sufficient quantity of good water to be got for every purpose, as there are already two wells within the castle and eight or ten in the grounds. Also the Monkland Canal is near enough and high enough for additional supply. Also there is a public washing green at the Molindinar Burn. (4) There are near as many stones on the ground as to be sufficient for the building.”

(In 1794 an inch and a half pipe was laid from the Monkland Canal to the Infirmary, the water being filtered, and later a gratuitous supply was received from the Glasgow Water Works.)

On 18th May, 1792, the foundation stone of the Glasgow Royal Infirmary was laid by the Lord Provost, assisted by James Adams, Architect, and Messrs. Morrison and Burns, Contractors, with this benediction :—“ May the Grand Architect of the Universe grant a blessing upon the foundation stone we have just laid, and may He enable us to raise a superstructure upon it which, to the latest ages, shall prove a house of refuge and consolation to the diseased poor of this city and neighbourhood.

After this the brethren gave three loud huzzas, which were accompanied with the joyful acclamations of an immense crowd of spectators highly gratified with the spectacle.”

The Infirmary at this time consisted of the present front block and cost £9,000.

The 1st Annual Report (1795) drawn up by Mr. George Jardine, is very interesting :—“ The Infirmary was opened on 8th December, 1794. No fewer than 31 important operations have been performed and all of them, with one exception, proved successful. The attending physicians and surgeons have given medical advice daily in the Waiting Room to upwards of 3,000 persons. 276 patients were admitted to the wards. The charitable subscribers may thus with truth enter into the joys of the oppressed mother and children when their staff and support is again restored to them—of the husband who again receives with a glad and grateful heart the partner of his joys and griefs—and of the parent who embraces his darling child restored to health and strength when scarce a gleam of hope had remained.”

In a fine piece of rhetoric they appeal for subscriptions to carry on this good work, and end up with the threat :—“ That those who, under the influence of temper and prejudice and imposing on themselves by some miserable pretence have hitherto shut their ears to the voice of affliction, and, solely devoted to themselves, their business, or their pleasures have suffered the stream of affluence to be absorbed which it was their duty to diffuse . . . that they themselves will soon be met by that awful change which must soon strip them of what they hold with so firm a grasp and lay them low with those who cried for help, but were not heard, and by hardheartedness and indifference have been hastened to their graves.”

In the 1796 Report again the non-contributors are reminded “ that *they* are not exempted from the ills of life, and that the time may come when the assistance and sympathy of others may be more useful and comfortable to them than all those possessions which they preserve with so much concern.”

“ The Managers are sorry they have nothing but acknowledgments to make for the faithful and useful labours of the Medical gentlemen who, leaving their own business almost two hours every day, and in the busiest part of it, to employ their time in the painful and fatiguing labours of the Infirmary.”

In 1797 it was found necessary “ to furnish two more wards, to erect a porch at the east door, and to fit up presses for keeping the surgical instruments in a proper manner.” The Managers report “ that in point of situation, good air, abundance of good water and convenient accommodation of the patients, the Royal

Infirmary at Glasgow is not excelled by any other establishment of the same kind in Britain, of which they have had information."

The Physicians' and Surgeons' clerks were not at first residents, but "they were not all to be absent at one time." In August, 1796, it was suggested that it would be of advantage to have the physician's clerk to live and board in the house. They were charged £30 per annum for board and residence, and were all non-qualified. The surgeon's clerk acted also as apothecary until 1800, when "Mr. John Allan was appointed house apothecary, to have sole charge of the shop, and of providing, preparing and dispensing medicines. In this appointment the Directors think themselves particularly fortunate, as Mr. Allan, being an ordained minister, has agreed, without any additional salary, to discharge the important duty of Chaplain to the Infirmary" (later he was given £10 for this office). Presumably the surgeons' clerks became resident about the same time.

Clinical lectures on medical cases were apparently given at the very beginning of the Infirmary's history, as in September, 1794, Drs. Hope and Cleghorn applied for permission to deliver them. In May, 1797, Mr. Burns made a similar proposal to hold lectures on Clinical Surgery.

In November, 1797, we see the beginning of our present ambulance service in the proposal to purchase two sedan chairs for conveying patients to hospital. For convenience these were kept in Mr. John Hamilton's Sugar Works in the Candleriggs. The chief object in providing these chairs was not, however, the

comfort of the patients, but to avoid infection of the public from using a chair which had conveyed a fever patient to the hospital.

In 1800 the appeal for funds was very clamant. “The awful pressure of the time, and the alarming scarcity and dearth of the necessities of life, which is particularly felt in an infirmary, have at once operated to diminish their funds and to increase their expenditure.”

In 1805 the Managers consider that the work done by the physicians and surgeons has become so great that it will be necessary to reward them with more than thanks.

In Edinburgh it is stated that the physicians and surgeons attend daily and very considerable salaries have been appointed to them since the year 1751—£30 to each physician and surgeon from the Directors, and £90 to each from the King.

In Liverpool regular attendance was only twice a week, and the physicians and surgeons got no fixed salaries, but got pupils’ fees. It was decided to give at the Glasgow Royal Infirmary £30 to each physician and £10 to each surgeon, but only after two years’ work had been done gratis. Application was also made to the King for a further grant.

In this year’s Report also reference is made to the gift of £1,200 from the First Regiment of Royal Glasgow Volunteers, the following inscription being put up in the Board Room :—

“On the 6th day of May, 1802, the First Regiment of Royal Glasgow Volunteers, commanded by Lieutenant-Colonel Corbett, previous to their reduction,

appropriated the whole surplus of their funds, amounting to £1,200, for the benefit of this Institution."

"During an eventful period of eight years their conduct was marked by loyalty and patriotism. When their services were no longer required their last act was dedicated to beneficence. The thanks of their King and country have recorded the first; in gratitude of the last the Managers of the Glasgow Royal Infirmary ordered this inscription."

In the Report of the year 1810 the Directors state that the fees paid by students exceed £200 per annum, with the prospect of a still further increase. They, therefore, recommend a salary of £50 to be paid to each of the Physicians and £20 to each of the Surgeons, after two years have been attended gratis.

In 1816 the building of the North Block was started (the "back wards" of the original Medical House). The number of patients in the wards having increased from 150 to 178, the Managers' consulting room required to be utilised for patients. Typhus Fever also had increased to an alarming extent, and Hospital Erysipelas had appeared in several of the wards. This block cost about £4,000.

Great difficulty was experienced at this time in dealing with the large number of Typhus Fever cases (not at that time differentiated from Typhoid Fever), and at the same time attending to the ordinary run of hospital cases:

From 1819 to 1823 the average number of fever cases in the Hospital was 34, two wards in the North Block sufficing for their accommodation. One ward was kept empty so that cases from other wards could be

transferred into it, and time given for thorough cleaning, and thus prevent Hospital contagion.

In the autumn of 1823 Fever again became very prevalent, and four wards were necessary to accommodate the cases. This led to overcrowding in the ordinary wards, and it was found impossible to keep an empty ward.

The House of Recovery at Spring Gardens was refitted to meet the emergency.

In 1825 Fever cases were more than one-third of all patients, and the erection of a Fever Hospital was recommended.

In 1827, in order to make the reports of more statistical value, the physicians and surgeons were recommended to note "in addition to the name and ages of the patients their trade and occupation and their residence, with remarks on the healthiness or unhealthiness of the situation."

"That to procure an accurate meteorological journal of the weather, a barometer, thermometer and rain gauge be established at the Infirmary; that an exact note of the temperature and weight of the atmosphere, and the quantity of rain, and also of the points of the wind be taken and recorded each day by the apothecary or some of the clerks appointed for the purpose.

"That each physician prepare a list of such diseases as he has treated during the year, with the results of treatment.

"That each surgeon give similar details, with a list of the operations performed, also the different mode pursued."

This practice does not appear to have been continued for long. In 1827 Typhus Fever was so prevalent as

to make it imperative to commence the erection of the Fever Hospital (Central Block or so-called Surgical Block). Meanwhile a wooden booth containing 80 beds was erected within the grounds.

Dr. Corkindale in his report for the year 1831 stated that in November 374 beds were occupied, and of these 213 were fever cases—" Nevertheless, an unemployed Cotton Mill in King Street, Mile-End, had to be fitted with 135 beds for cases unable to gain admission to the Hospital."

The mortality in Fever cases was stated to be 1 in 9 in 1833, considerably greater than that in practice notwithstanding " our airy, well-ventilated wards, our clean bed cloths, our quiet retirement, our attentive nursing, our ample stores of medicinal and dietetic resources, to say nothing of skilful treatment."

The operations in surgery have now amounted to 100, 46 being amputations.

The number of physicians has increased to three, and " subject still to the salutary check of an annual election, continue in office for three years; the junior physician, for the first year, to attend the Fever House and serve daily in the Waiting Room; the two seniors to take charge of the ordinary medical cases in the front building, and deliver Clinical lectures, and that each receive an annual salary of £50. The salary of the two senior surgeons is raised to £30."

Four lectures—two medical and two surgical—were now given. Formerly only one of each had been given.

In 1834 the Fever Hospital of 220 beds (the old Central Surgical Block) was completed this year at the cost of £8,292 9s. 3d.

"The Infirmary in its present state may be considered as *completed*. The ground will not admit of another capital building. Any more crowding in the site would be on many accounts improper. If additional accommodation be required erections for these purposes would be more convenient to the public in other quarters of the district."

"There are now 440 beds."

In 1835 one of the surgeons gave daily attendance at the Waiting Room, giving advice to medical and surgical cases indiscriminately, keeping notes of interesting cases. The prescriptions were made up by a dispensary pupil.

"Each applicant for advice will thus always find a practitioner at leisure ready to enter into a history of his case at the first visit, and at every subsequent visit he will meet the same person instructed by the recorded facts as to the complaint and as to the means of cure formerly employed.

"He will also at the same time be supplied with medicines that are genuine and properly prepared, calculated to do justice to the skill of the practitioner."

In 1836 a Resident Chaplain was appointed at a salary of £50 per annum. Various additions were made to the Fever House, raising its cost to £10,000.

The first Superintendent, a Mr. Martin, was appointed in 1838. He resigned from ill health in 1843, when Dr. R. Scott Orr was appointed Superintendent and Apothecary at a salary of £175 per annum. In 1838 an addition at the west-end of the Infirmary "for apartments for the Chaplain and Superintendent, and a Committee Room for the Directors; and a dormitory for night nurses was started."

In 1843 the late Superintendent's house was utilised for paying patients suffering from "simple and eruptive fevers."

The completion of the Fever Hospital does not appear to have solved the difficulty of providing accommodation for fever cases in times of epidemics. It was proposed to build an additional Fever Hospital in St. Andrew's Square, but this was vetoed by public agitation. A house at Bridgeton was then purchased, and after a law suit the Managers established their right to treat fever cases there. In 1847, however, "the City Parochial Board became satisfied of the necessity of an active interference on their part to provide accommodation for the daily increasing number of sufferers from Fever, and having obtained possession of the old Town's Hospital . . . proceeded to prepare it for fever patients."

The Parochial Board of the Barony Parish also erected fever sheds in Anderston. Changes in the Poor Law in Scotland permitted the Parochial Boards to levy by assessment such funds as they require for the relief of the poor, and led to them providing for fever cases.

Next year, however, 1848, the old plan of sending Parish cases to the Royal Infirmary was resumed, the Parish paying 15s. for each case. The Fever Hospital in 1848 was reserved for cholera cases, 139 cases being admitted, of which 71 recovered and 68 died.

In 1851 small-pox was unusually prevalent, and 163 cases were admitted, with 30 deaths. The great majority of cases were among natives of the Highlands,

some having been actually sent from home with the disease on them. "The mortality . . . was chiefly confined to individuals who had not received the benefit of vaccination."

This year the extension at Bridgeton was disposed of. In 1852 a Museum of Pathology was instituted.

In this year, also, with the view of opening up and improving the approach to the Cathedral, "the mound in front of the Infirmary and the Janitor's Lodge was removed."

Three subsidiary wards were set apart for surgical cases . . . "enabling the surgeons to combat successfully with hospital gangrene by carefully separating from injuries and cases of operation the numerous cases of burns and extensive ulcerating surfaces, whose contaminating influence is apt to produce the most baneful results."

In 1855 we have the erection of a new building "consisting of an Inspection Room, a Museum, and a large and commodious Dead House, suited to the present and future wants of the establishment."

The hour of the chief's visit was at this time changed from 2 p.m., at first to 12 and then to 8.30 a.m. "Each medical attendant to enter into a Minute Book . . . the time of his arrival at the Infirmary.

"When circumstances occur to prevent a medical attendant being present, he shall send the earliest notice of his intended absence to the Superintendent, who shall post it in the Hall, and arrange immediately with the other medical attendants to supply his place."

The physicians and surgeons were now appointed for 5 years, to attend the Dispensary daily at 2 p.m.

during their first year; the physician to act in the Fever wards in his second year; after that in the medical wards, and during the fourth and fifth years deliver Clinical lectures.

After retirement they were not eligible for a year, and if again appointed started the curriculum *de novo*.

The surgeons now received the same salary as the physicians, £50 per annum, "with one half of the fees of the Clinical Lectures."

The war at this time (1854) produced a great demand for medical men and greatly increased the number of students—to 144 in 1855.

In connection with taking out a new insurance policy in 1856 the whole buildings and furniture were valued at £18,000.

In 1857 we find the Dispensary staff increased to two physicians and two surgeons daily, at the salary of £30 per annum. The 787 cases of Fever this year are classified as "179 cases of small-pox, scarlet fever, etc., 142 mild febrile disease, 146 cases of the kind called Typhoid, and 320 cases of genuine Typhus."

This gives the lowest fever record since 1826. The figures show decennial rises and falls. In the outbreak of 1847 there were over 5,000 cases, but this year, 1857, no great outbreak occurred.

Vaccination as part of the Dispensary work was started in this year. The Managers forwarded a memorial to the Lord Advocate to have vaccination made compulsory by law as in England, with a view of diminishing the terrible mortality of this disease in the young.

The physicians' and surgeons' tenure of office was now increased to 8 years.

In 1861 the new Surgical Hospital was completed (North Block) at a cost of £12,206, or £65 per bed. "The wards being more spacious, better lighted, and possess more efficient means of ventilation. A new operating theatre has been constructed in the upper floor of the building to accommodate 200 students."

In 1861 Mr. Lister was elected a surgeon to the G.R.I., and Dr. W. T. Gairdner a physician, and in 1863 Dr. S. J. Moore, pathologist.

The overcrowding of the fever wards in times of epidemic still continued, and in 1865 two physicians, five physicians' assistants, and twelve nurses and servants took fever—one physician and four nurses died.

The Managers pointed out to the Parochial and Police Boards that the population of Glasgow was now so great that they were quite unable to take in all cases of fever in times of epidemic, and that these Boards must be responsible for the treatment of cases they were unable to take into the Royal Infirmary—the Managers fixed the limit of fever cases to be taken in at 175. This appears to have had a good effect in lessening the proportion of officials taking fever.

For the purpose of lessening the spread of hospital gangrene it was also considered advisable to restrict the number of beds in the Medical House to 241, and for the Surgical House, 144.

The permanent City Hospital in Parliamentary Road having led to a considerable reduction in the number of fever cases, the Managers decided to devote the north half of the Fever Block to medical and surgical cases, and the south to fever cases, the latter being isolated by the erection of a staircase at the south end,

and being closed at its north end. Ten years later the Infirmary ceased admitting cases of fever.

In 1867 Dr. Moses Thomas succeeded Dr. John Thomson as Superintendent, which post he held till 1902, when he was succeeded by Dr. Maxtone Thom, the present Superintendent. The Dorcas Society and Convalescent Home at Bothwell are mentioned in the Reports of this year for the first time.

In 1869 it was thought "proper to discontinue interring the unclaimed dead in the Burying ground behind the Infirmary, both on account of the large number of burials that have already taken place there, and of the proximity of the graves to the Hospital. They have also memorialised the Magistrates to discontinue interments in the adjoining grounds of the Cathedral. The Infirmary unclaimed dead are now buried in Sighthill Cemetery. The expense of sepulture is thus nearly doubled . . . the additional expense to be paid out of the funds of the Institution."

In 1870 Dr. Joseph Coats was appointed Curator of Museum, and this year negotiations began between the University and the Infirmary with regard to the building of a new Infirmary in the western districts.

In 1872 "the Managers of the Royal Infirmary came to be unanimously of opinion that amalgamation was not expedient in the interests of either institution."

"Various changes in the staff occurred at this time owing to the Professors in the University transferring over to the Western Infirmary."

An arrangement between the two boards was made for an interchange of patients when either had spare beds for cases which the other could not receive. The

salaries of the chiefs were raised to 100 guineas as compensation for loss from reduction in students' fees.

In 1873 the number of physicians was increased to five, with an additional physician for the Fever Hospital, and five surgeons. All were now allowed to give Clinical Lectures.

The visiting hour was now 9 a.m. In 1871 a new and larger Dispensary was opened, and also a Nurses' Home. In 1873 the improvements started in the wards several years ago were completed by getting baths in all the wards of the Medical House.

The ground to the east of the Infirmary, used as a washing green, was purchased for £3,005.

In 1875 the Molindinar Burn was covered over and a new street made. A hoist was made in the Surgical House at a cost of £380, proving "a great comfort and relief to patients brought in suffering from accidents."

A Medical School connected with the Infirmary was opened in 1876. At this time also, separate departments for ear and throat and nose cases and the diseases of women were opened. That for eye cases was opened in 1886.

Mr. W. J. Fleming and Dr. J. W. Anderson started giving lectures to nurses.

In 1878 the Hospital in Parliamentary Road was put under the management of the Royal Infirmary for the purpose of providing for more patients.

Mrs. Strong was appointed matron during this year and, except for an interval when she left to start a nursing home in Glasgow, she held this appointment till 1903, when she was succeeded by the present matron, Miss Jane Melrose.

The Residents' Dining Hall was opened in 1880.

The Dispensary buildings were turned into a Nurses' Home, and the Dispensary buildings opened in the New Medical School. "When these improvements are carried out the Hospital will, in the opinion of the Managers, be as nearly perfect as any such institution can be, and will thereafter require a comparatively small expenditure for extraordinary purposes."

The telephone was introduced into the Hospital in 1882, and the Managers note "that ere long they may be able to have direct communication with each member of the staff at his own house (this was effected in 1889).

The board paid by the Residents was discontinued this year.

This year erysipelas cases were isolated in a new building over Vicar's Alley.

Additional sleeping accommodation for nurses is again required, and the building of a Nurses' Home is contemplated, "so as to render it unnecessary for any of them to sleep in the wards—a practice which is not conducive to health. There being still 30 day nurses, 12 night nurses and 10 probationers scattered throughout the Hospital, sleeping in small rooms off the wards, where they are exposed day and night to the atmosphere of the ward. . . ."

The Home was opened in 1888.

In 1888 the Medical School became St. Mungo's College, and "as it was necessary that wards be provided for the Professor of Clinical Medicine in the College, the holder of the office was appointed physician to the Infirmary."

Separate Clinical and Pathological classes for women were started in 1890 in the Infirmary, and the Ophthalmic Institution was taken over by the Infirmary.

Negotiations for the re-construction of the Royal Infirmary started in 1897.

Sir David Richmond opened a fund for the reconstruction of the front block of the buildings as a memorial of Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee, but later consideration showed that nothing short of the reconstruction of the whole building would be sufficient, and that the cost would amount to £500,000. Mr. James Miller is the architect. The foundation stone was laid by his Royal Highness, the Prince of Wales, on 24th April, 1907.

The progress of the building since then is familiar to all, and the new G.R.I. will be a magnificent institution, though none of us will witness the passing of the old familiar landmarks without regret.

The difficulty of compiling correct lists of the Residents has already been referred to.


